

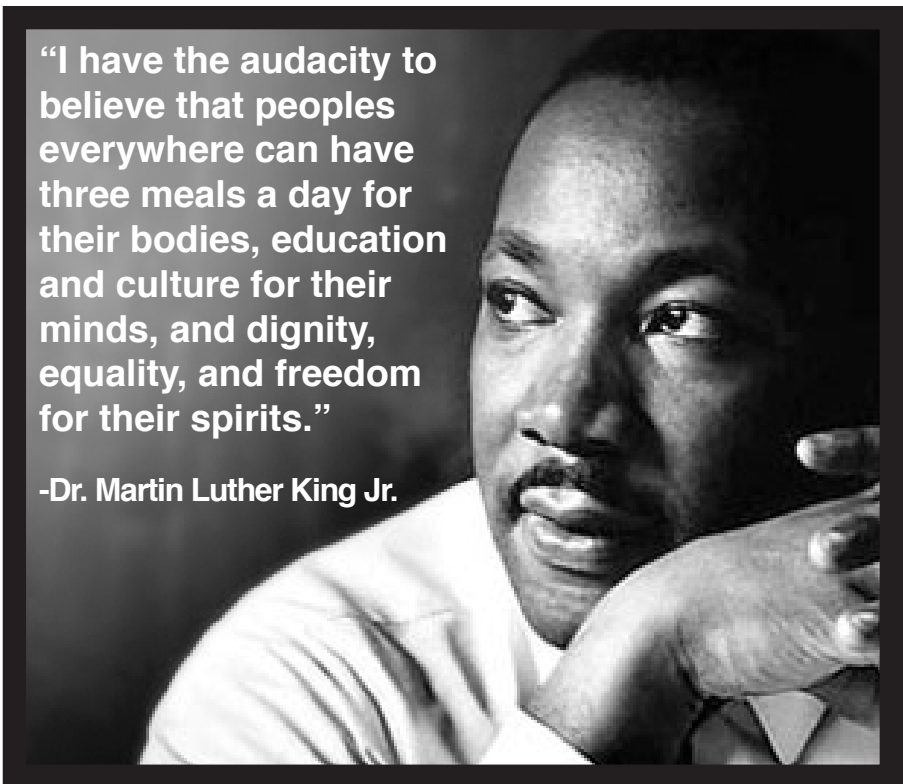
Coalition For Strong Jobs And Quality Services Kick Off Event
